

Mandate to All Believers

“Therefore go and make disciples of all nations,” (Matthew 28:19) NIV

Jesus gave a command to all believers before He ascended to be seated at the right hand of the Father: go preach and make disciples of all men, women, and children. (Mark 16:14)

What is a disciple? A disciple is one who is a learner or apprentice, a follower of Jesus Christ. Disciples do what their teachers instruct them to according to the lesson plan. *“Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed in him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free” (John 8:31-32)*

All believers are to make disciples of all nations. The first place we start is in our own backyard, witnessing to our neighbors. What do I say? You share your testimony about how God saved you. Second, once you have established a foundation in the teachings of the Word, you mentor others. The Holy Spirit will connect you to the right person.

- A disciple pursues to imitate Jesus, so they become equipped to instruct and disciple others in the way of God.
