

Prayer *a certain place*

"Now it came to pass, as He was praying in *a certain place*, when He ceased, that one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples." (Luke 11:1)

The first thing the disciples noticed about Jesus' prayer life was that He was coming from a certain place. That place was solitude, and Jesus was having a conversation with His Father. The disciples wanted to pray like Jesus and asked for instructions on how to pray.

There are no formulas in the Kingdom of God for PRAYER, but we observe principles and prayers throughout the Bible. A few to mention give us an understanding of HOW to pray: prayer of faith, prayer of agreement, and corporate prayer. Etc.

What is the *certain place*? This is where we go to have fellowship and conversation with Father God. This is your prayer closet, alone with God. You may take a cup of coffee or tea to relax with your Father. God wants you to come to Him the way you are. You approach God washed by the blood of Jesus.



God wants a relationship with you, and He sent the Holy Spirit for you to be the comforter and helper in prayer. (Rom.8:26-27) God will always honour His Word in prayer. His WORD is His WILL. Faith in God's Word will move the hand of God. Prayer without ceasing is keeping our hearts tuned to the Father, developing a relationship, and open daily communication with Father God. (I Thess. 5:16-28)

We are the temple of the Holy Spirit. Jesus dwells in *a certain place* focused on PRAYER! We decree our certain place is the HOUSE OF PRAYER. "And said unto them, *It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.*" (Matt. 21:13)
