

5 Essential Points of Jesus' Birth

"For unto us a child is born, unto us, a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace." (Isaiah 9:6)

1. Fulfillment of Prophecy - The prophet Isaiah foretold that a virgin would conceive miraculously and carry a child, a son called "Immanuel," defined "God with us" (Isaiah 7:14) Micah's prophecy said the birthplace would be Bethlehem and the one would be ruler over Israel. (Micah 5:2)

2. The Virgin Birth - In Matthew 1:18-25 and Luke 1:26-38, the angel Gabriel announced to Mary she would conceive a child by the Holy Spirit. The incarnation, which affirms the divine nature and sinless humity, makes Jesus the immaculate conception. In Jonn 1:1, 14 show Jesus' dual being completely God and fully man without human lineage stained by sin.

3. Humble Birth Place - Luke 2:7 tells us there was no place in the inn, Jesus in a manger or stable, as we understand, demonstrating God's heart for the lost and less fortunate. Philippians 2:6-7 says Jesus, although He was God, "made himself nothing, adopting the very nature of a servant".

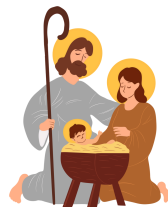
4. Announment to the Shepherds & Magi Visit - The shepherds were told by an angelic host about the birth of Jesus; all men could receive salvation from God. (Luke 2:8-20). Magi from the east, guided by a star, brought gifts for the newborn king: myrrh, franckincense, and gold. (Matthew 2:1-2) The prophetic symbols confirmed Jesus the King to all nations and light to the getiles

5. God with Us - Jesus was born a baby of virgin birth, but he did not remain a baby. Jesus grew up became man, and had an earthly ministry. John 1:14 reveals to us the truth of Jesus being born and becoming a man: "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us." In Matthew 1:23, "Immanuel" ultimately suffered and became a sacrifice so we may be redeemed from sin. Jesus died on the cross and He is risen that we may have eternal life.
