

Now Concerning Spiritual Gifts

"Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be ignorant: " (I Cor. 12:1 NKJV)

The apostle Paul begins his teaching on spiritual gifts because he does not want the Church to be ignorant or misinformed about them. The scripture challenges us to understand that operating in the gifts of the Holy Spirit involves special endowments of supernatural energy. "NOW ABOUT the spiritual gifts (the special endowments of supernatural energy), brethren, I do not want you to be misinformed. (I Cor. 12:1 AMPC)

In other words, the Church must not remain uninformed about how the Holy Spirit moves and manifests through believers. This knowledge is essential. Spiritual gifts are not a mystery reserved for a select few—they are meant to be understood, received, and used by every believer.



The gifts operate within the Church and the marketplace to create beneficial effects for humankind. The gifts are not about performance or man's abilities. The manifestation of the Holy Spirit is as HE wills. (I Cor. 12:11)"But to each one is given the manifestation of the (Holy) Spirit (the evidence, the spiritual illumination of the Spirit) for good and profit." (I Cor. 12:7 AMPC)

NINE GIFTS CATEGORIZED (I Cor. 12:1-11)

THE REVELATION GIFTS (*These reveal something*): 1. The word of wisdom 2. The word of knowledge 3. Discerning of spirits

THE POWER GIFTS (*These do something*): 1. The gift of faith 2. The working of miracles 3. The gifts of healings

THE INSPIRATIONAL or VOCAL GIFTS (These say something):

1. Prophecy 2. Different kinds of tongues 3. Interpretation of tongues

As we begin this series on the nine gifts of the Holy Spirit, may our hearts be open to learn, receive, and function in the power and purpose the Spirit has made available to us.
