

Evangelism & Discipleship: Our Mission

Greetings in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ! We welcome you to New Beginnings Church. If this is your first time or you are a regular attendee, we trust you will enjoy the Worship & Word. This month we are focusing on MISSIONS! We have our guest Brother Micheal Blesson ministering in several sessions during our Missions Week June 2-8. We are excited for our church to hear what God is doing in India and around the world!



"And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the Gospel to every creature." (Mark 16:15)

Evangelism is the starting point—it is the joyful act of bringing forth the "Good News." It is the message that Jesus Christ, the Son of the living God, came to this world, died on the cross for our sins, and rose on the third day. Through His sacrifice, eternal life is available to everyone who believes and calls upon His name (John 3:16).

The word itself carries a beautiful meaning: derived from the Greek eu ("well") and aggelos ("messenger"), an evangelist is simply a "messenger of good." This matches the Anglo-Saxon roots of our word Gospel (godspell), which literally means a "good story."

Discipleship is what follows that "good news." While evangelism plants the seed, discipleship is the process of tending the soil so a life can grow in Christ. As we look at the Great Commission in Matthew 28:19-20, Jesus doesn't just call us to reach people, but to "teach all nations" and show them how to "observe all things" He commanded.

At New Beginnings, our mission covers both:

Reaching the World (Evangelism): Supporting works like Brother Micheal Blesson's ministry in India to share the Gospel.

Growing Together (Discipleship): Connecting in our Men's and Women's groups to learn, mentor, and live out the Word of God every day.

"Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen". Matthew 28:19-20
